What is CASANYYS?

CASA: Advocates for Children of New York State is a state-wide organization that works to provide volunteer advocates for children who have been abused and neglected.

Our goal is to help children find homes that are safe and permanent.

2009 Statistics:

- Local CASA Programs served an estimated **3,765** children.
- CASA volunteers numbered **895**.
- Each CASA volunteer contributed, on average, approximately **107 hours of time**.
- The total number of hours contributed by CASA volunteers is **100,672**.
- Total number of cases: **3,236**.
- Total number of cases closed: **1,310**.

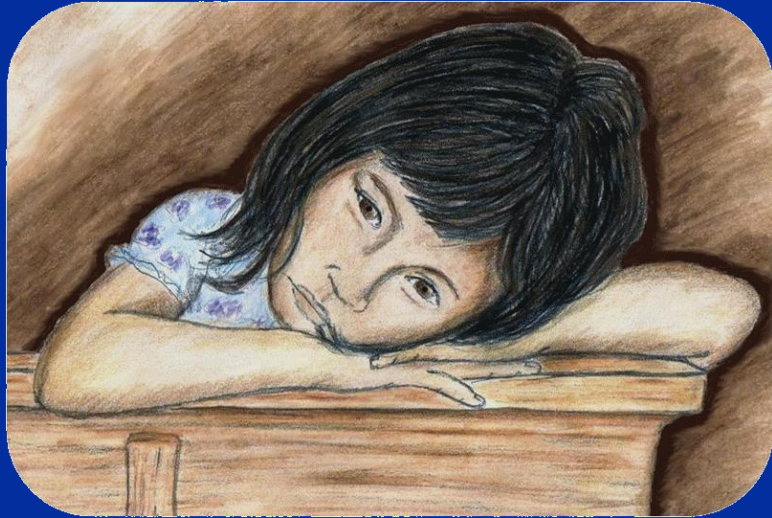
